S.T.A.R.S. BEGINNING WEST AFRICAN DRUMMING

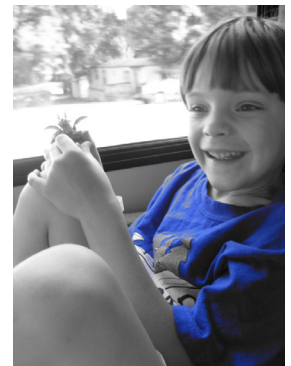
